Assembly is 30 minutes before the start time for the round to give time to setup the field.  
Archers arriving late for assembly will have to fit in with the field.<sup>2</sup>

For longer rounds (12 dozen) assembly is at 10:00 for a 10:30 start.

For afternoon shoots (ie rounds of less than 9 dozen) assembly is at 13:00 for a 13:30 start  
For rounds of nine dozen assembly is at 11:00 for an 11:30 start

We normally setup on the right of the field to leave space, if possible, for beginners or archers doing tuning or free practice on the left. Priority is always given to those shooting the day's round, so it may on occasion not be possible for any tuning or free practice.
